
Under the auspices of HE Sheikh Hamad Bin Khalifa Al Thani, Emir of Qatar, Qatalum, was officially set off on April 12th, 2010.

Located in Messaied, approximately 40 km south of the capital, Doha, is no less than the largest aluminium plant ever launched, with a capacity in the first phase of 585,000 tonnes of primary aluminium, all to be shipped as value added aluminium casthouse products.


Qatalum's state-of-the-art cast house products are value-added extrusion ingots and foundry alloys that meet the stringent quality standards of its global customer base. Used in a variety of industries including the automotive, construction, engineering and in the manufacturing of consumer goods, by the end of its journey, Qatalum's aluminium reaches the entire global community.

With a 1350 MW natural gas power plant to ensure a stable supply of electricity, and other complex facilities including a carbon plant, port and storage facilities – not to mention twin 1.2km potlines – Qatalum is at the forefront of the massive switches in momentum in the industry to new, emerging markets, as well as Qatar's emergence as a regional powerhouse.

Most central to Qatalum's success is the use of HAL250 technology, an economical and environmental-friendly electrolytic reduction technology pioneered by one of Qatalum's partners(Norsk-Hydro of Norway)
